## SUBMISSION GUIDELINES FOR THE GAKUSHUIN JOURNAL OF INTERNATIONAL STUDIES

- The Gakushuin Journal of International Studies welcomes original articles concerned with any aspects of international studies in the humanities or social sciences.
- To be considered for publication, submissions should be written in English, not have been previously published, and should not be under review for publication elsewhere in any language.
- The Submissions Review Panel will review and determine which articles will be published at its sole discretion.
- Article length should be limited to 10,000 words or less, and the following information should be provided on the first page.
  - Title.
  - · Author name(s). Author affiliation(s) if any.
  - Contact information of the Author.
  - Summary of the article in not more than 150 words.
- Manuscripts must be double-spaced with 12-point type and 1 inch (2.5 cm.) margins
  including extracts, notes, and references.
- Use parenthetical in-text citation, and author-date formatting for references per Chicago Manual of Style, 16th edition (Chicago: University of Chicago Press, 2010), pp. 786-810.
- All bibliographical references should be included at the end of the article in alphabetical order.
- Concerning the copyright of the submitted paper:
  - Copyright of the submitted paper belongs to the author.
  - •The holder of the copyright implicitly grants to Gakushuin Women's College permission to print, publish, and distribute the paper in hard copy and online,

including permission to make copies and grant access to the public.
