SUBMISSION GUIDELINES FOR THE GAKUSHUIN JOURNAL OF INTERNATIONAL STUDIES

- The Gakushuin Journal of International Studies welcomes original articles concerned with any aspects of international studies in the humanities or social sciences.
- To be considered for publication, submissions should be written in English, not have been previously published, and should not be under review for publication elsewhere in any language.
- The Submissions Review Panel will review and determine which articles will be published at its sole discretion.
- Article length should be limited to 10,000 words or less, and the following information should be provided on the first page.
 - Title.
 - Author name(s). Author affiliation(s) if any.
 - Contact information of the Author.
 - Summary of the article in not more than 150 words.
- Manuscripts must be double-spaced with 12-point type and 1 inch (2.5 cm.) margins including extracts, notes, and references.
- Use parenthetical in-text citation, and author-date formatting for references per *Chicago Manual of Style*, 16th edition (Chicago: University of Chicago Press, 2010), pp. 786-810.
- All bibliographical references should be included at the end of the article in alphabetical order.
- Concerning the copyright of the submitted paper:
 - Copyright of the submitted paper belongs to the author.
 - The holder of the copyright implicitly grants to Gakushuin Women's College permission to print, publish, and distribute the paper in hard copy and online,

- including permission to make copies and grant access to the public.
- The owner of the copyright shall grant Gakushuin University Library, which manages and operates Gakushuin University Library Information & Multimedia System Institution Repository (GLIM-IR), permission for digitization, registration in the repository, and permission to allow browsing and downloading by public users.
 - Regarding digitization and internet publication, authors of manuscripts will obtain prior consent from other holders of the copyright:
 - a) From all coauthors
 - b) From the holder of the copyright to any illustrations or photographs included in the manuscript.
 - Upon request, authors may withhold permission for digitization or publication on the Web.
